The best way to do this is to ensure your batteries are not outdated and are in optimal working condition.

How to check the age of your two-way radio battery

- 1) Locate the 3 digit number located on the battery label
- 2) The first digit represents the year the battery was manufactured
- 3) The next two digits represent the week the battery was manufactured

Example: The above battery is dated 437 meaning the battery was manufactured the 37th week of 2004 (approx Sept 5, 2004).
